

WSVS is located next to Westmead Private Hospital and is only minutes from Westmead Public Hospital, where all our specialists have public appointments. Each of the vascular surgeons have many years' experience, with national and international reputations in the management of vascular disorders, as well as a long and continuing track record at both Westmead Public and Westmead private hospitals.

WSVS four Vascular and Endovascular Surgeons have extensive experience in treating the full spectrum of vascular conditions including:

- Varicose veins
- · Mesenteric ischemia
- Carotid artery disease
- Deep venous thrombosis & treatment
- Thoracic outlet syndrome
- · Lower limb ulceration

- Acute & chronic arterial disease
- Aortic disease
- Lymphoedema
- · Diabetic feet & ulcerations
- Hyperhidrosis

The team is dedicated to providing patients with the best possible outcomes through exceptional medical and surgical care, with the ability to diagnose, investigate and manage patients with the full spectrum of vascular disorders with endovascular (arterial and venous) therapies.

GPs and specialists can refer directly to WSVS and to their vascular ultrasound lab offering patients easy access to vascular investigations. As part of an ongoing service this group will continue to offer a vascular ultrasound to inpatients at Westmead Private Hospital.

WSVS offers two consulting suites, a large treatment room, treadmill room and attached to the clinic is a dedicated Vascular Lab that features state of the art diagnostic vascular ultrasound where the team performs non-invasive testing using Doppler ultrasound techniques on-site. All medical practitioners are able to access this service with the vast majority of all our referred scans being available bulk billed or no gap.

Scanning services include routine and urgent:

- · Venous scans, including varicose veins,
- Arterial scans including both lower and upper limbs, aortic, carotid mesenteric scans
- DVT and all manner of thrombotic disorders
- Diagnostic pressure studies, ABIs
